Re. Mitsubishi Asian Children's Enikki Festa 2019-2020

Thanks for your school's participation in the Mitsubishi Asian Children's Enikki Festa 2019-2020

It gives me pleasure to inform you that for the 14th cycle of the Enikki Festa 2019-2020, we received a total number of 10588 entries from 28 States and Union Territories of India. The National level screening of the entries was done by a jury consisting of Art teachers and Professional artists on 22nd and 25th December 2019. The jury selected 08 entries for the International Screening Committee to be sent to Japan and **245** entries for Local Organizers' Awards. (*As per the terms, we cannot disclose names of the 08 selected entries sent to Japan for International Screening*).

The International Screening Committee will meet in Tokyo, Japan in April 2020 to select one Grand Prix, 3 International Organizers' and four Excellence Award winners from each of 24 countries and the region which participated in the current cycle. The results of the International Awards will be informed as and when received from Japan by us (sometime around last week of May 2020).

While screening entries, the jury observed that many entries were not as per the specifications mentioned in the Entry Guidelines i.e.

- ☞ Some entries were oversized
- ☞ Some drawings/paintings were horizontally drawn
- ☞ Some sent only single instead of five drawings and essays by each student
- ☞ Some had cut & pasted the drawing or essay
- ☞ Some had copied the figures of cartoons etc. from books
- ☞ Some children were overage
- ☞ Some entry forms were not signed and certified by the concerned school Principal or Teacher
- ☞ In some cases, the jury doubted that teacher or parents might have helped in drawings and essay writing

To encourage participating children, we will give certificates to all, irrespective of the fact that the entries sent by some of them did not meet the requirements as mentioned in the Entry Guidelines. The list of the Local Organizers' Award winners is attached. Participation certificates, Prizes for winners and a letter of appreciation for the school will be sent by the end of April 2020.

We thank you once again for your participation in this important art festival and look forward for your continued support.
